Grade Conversion

ESA uses the ISU system for grade conversion.

| ESA Grade | ISU Grade |
|-----------------------------|------------------|
| 90-100% (14-20) | A |
| 80-89% (8-13) | B |
| 70-79% (2-7) | C |
| 60-69% | D |
| 59% and below (less than 2) | F |

Credits Earned Conversion

Upon successful completion, students will receive credit for 2 of the following courses:

AGR 289.21 Introduction to International Agriculture (3 credit hours)
IDS 133.05 French History, Culture, and Civilization (OC-H) (3 credit hours)
INB 245.12 Business Studies Abroad (3 credit hours)

Grade Articulation Process:

Upon your program completion, an official transcript from your host institution will be sent to the Office of International Studies and Programs. Upon receipt, your transcript will be forwarded to the [Office of the Registrar](#) for evaluation. Your transcript and [Academic Planning Form](#) will be used together to determine the ISU equivalent credit, which will be entered into your ISU grade report. All grades earned during study abroad will impact your ISU cumulative GPA.
