

Hanze University Grade Conversion

Each institution has their own system for evaluating student coursework, which may include differences in the number of credit hours earned for courses. The following articulation information has been agreed upon by Illinois State University and your study abroad host institution.

Credits Earned Conversion

Hanze Credits Earned	ISU Credits Earned
10 credits	5 credits
8 credits	4 credits
6 credits	3 credits
5 credits	2.5 credits

COB students will receive 1 ISU credit for each 2 ECTS earned. In some courses, this means that credits will not match exactly ISU courses. So for example, 2.5 ISU credits will be granted for 5 ECTS classes but COB will waive the 0.5 hours for COB classes requirements. However, the University will still require 120 hours of which must be 42 senior hours for graduation.

Summer: students take INB 245.21 and INB 287 (3 hours each)

Fall/Spring: students choose their own courses

Grade Articulation Process:

Upon your program completion, an official transcript from your host institution will be sent to the Office of International Studies and Programs. Upon receipt, your transcript will be forwarded to the [Office of the Registrar](#) for evaluation. Your transcript and [Academic Planning Form](#) will be used together to determine the ISU equivalent credit, which will be entered into your ISU grade report. All grades earned during study abroad will impact your ISU cumulative GPA.
